Welcome to our latest edition of our newsletter. It has been another busy week as we head into our last week for term 3.



Numero Competition

Castletown Primary School students from Years 4 to 6 competed in the 2018 AFG Interschool Numero Challenge at the Esperance Civic Centre on Monday 10th September.

Participating schools included Scadden PS, Nulsen PS, Cascade PS, Munglinup PS and Norseman DHS.

Students competed in 4 different events. The first event was the Top Take where students worked independently to find the biggest possible take (sequence of cards solving a mathematical problem). Students then work in teams of 4 to solve the Team Top Take.

In the third event students played Numero games against competitors from other schools. The last and most exciting event is the Scramble, where teams solve the problem and relay their solution onto the display board all within 5 minutes.

The Castletown students worked competitively and collaboratively throughout the day. Castletown Primary School provided the Stewards, who supported Mr Weckert and Mr Barter, ensuring the running of a smooth and successful competition.

Congratulations to all the students that participated. The overall winning team was the Castletown Mathematical Marbles with the Scadden Subitisers finishing second and the Castletown Kings of Tables coming third. The Mathematical Marbles (James Powell, Ryan Thomas, Isaac Francis and Blayden Coussens) will travel to Perth to compete in the State Numero Competition in 4th term. Good luck boys.
